Spenser Theberge is a dancer, choreographer, and educator based in Los Angeles. He received his early training from Columbia Dance, and is a graduate of the Vancouver School of Arts and Academics, where he was named a 2005 YoungArts winner and a Presidential Scholar in the Arts. Along with his partner Jermaine Spivey, he was the inaugural artist-in-residence at the Juilliard School of Dance, where he received his BFA and was selected as a 2008 Princess Grace Awardee.

Theberge has taught at academic institutions, conservatories, and dance companies from across the globe including the University of Southern California's Kaufman School of Dance, California Institute for the Arts, the National Theater of Taiwan, Nuova Officina della Danza, CLI Conservatory, Hochschule fur Musik und Darstellende Kunst, and Springboard Danse.

He has performed the works of the world's most influential choreographers as a former dancer with the Nederlands Dans Theater and The Forsythe Company, serving as a cultural attache for Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands in 2012.

He has been a guest artist with Kidd Pivot, Gothenburg Opera Dance Company, the ARIAS Company, Astrid Boons, Dimitri Chamblas, and RGWW. His work has also been featured in art museums such as the Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles and The Broad Museum and on dance companies including Gibney Dance Company, Hubbard Street Dance Chicago, LA Dance Project, and Gothenburg Opera Dance Company, among others.
